Once a person came up to me with a criticism about me. He was probably right although I cannot now remember what his insight was.

My usual response is to tell the person that they are only touching the surface and if they want to know more about my failings, they need to talk to my wife. I try to never defend myself and I try

to learn from all feedback. There is almost always truth there somewhere. (I'm also aware that what this person sees in me could be what they see in themselves. Seeing ourselves in others usually bugs us.)

We have no reason to defend ourselves. We admit each week that we are pretty big sinners. If people see good in us at all it is due to the work of the Holy Spirit and Jesus. What are we trying to defend?

Paul says that in our baptism our old self died. (Romans 6:1ff) If we are dead, then the only life we now have is the life we received when we came out of the baptismal waters, the life Jesus gives us. A new life that will never die and live with Jesus eternally.

So don't defend that old Adam or Eve within you, they are certainly not worth it. Let all that stuff die and live the new life in Christ. A life free of condemnation and worry. A life hidden in Christ.


